Six crowded in a bedroom, no shoes and a bath only once a week. This is the sad state of over 100 children suffering from tuberculosis at the Rehabilitation Center of Cornești town, Republic of Moldova.

This institution has been lacking access to water for many years and basic hygiene conditions recall the postwar period.

Only a few pieces of rusty iron stuck on the playground indicate an institution for children. The interior of the building is even more dramatic with its endless corridors; the only furniture in bedrooms are the beds; bathrooms open only once a week and dirty toilets.

The medical treatment and daily needs are very expensive for these children.

The only sign of civilization is a TV set and a few old and broken toys, confiscated by teachers in order to avoid arguing among children.

To bring some happiness to these children, a charity event will be held from 18 to 20 March 2013, with the support of Amicale of the Council of Europe.

In the framework of this event you are invited to a handmade jewelry exhibition that will take place in the hall of the Palais (CoE) on 19 and 20 March from 11:30 to 15:00.

In addition, if you have clothes, school supplies, toys that your kids no longer use and effectively a good heart we will be grateful if you can give it for this cause.
